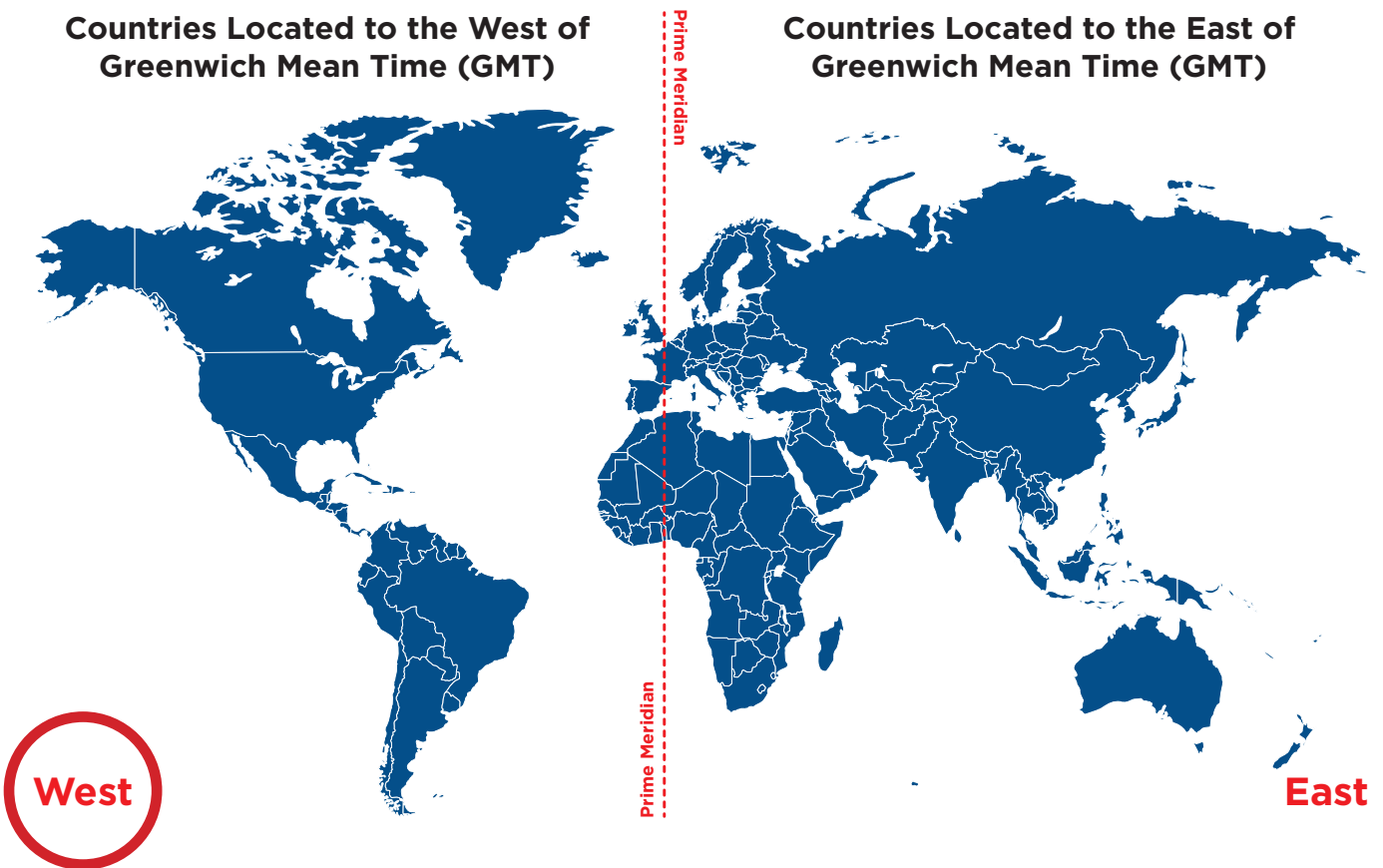


HOW TO CONVERT GMT TIME TO YOUR LOCAL TIME

Countries Located to the West of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)

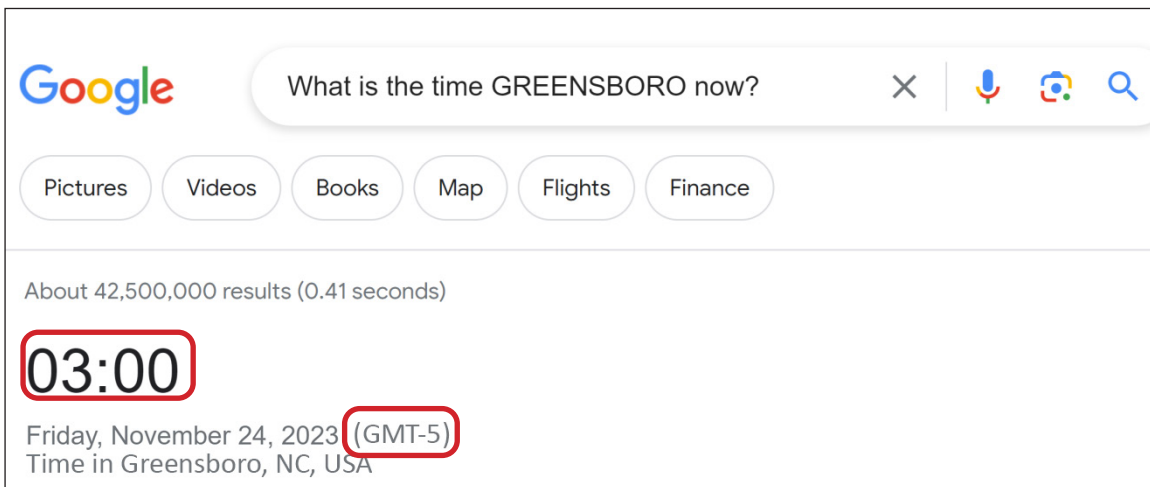
Countries Located to the East of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)



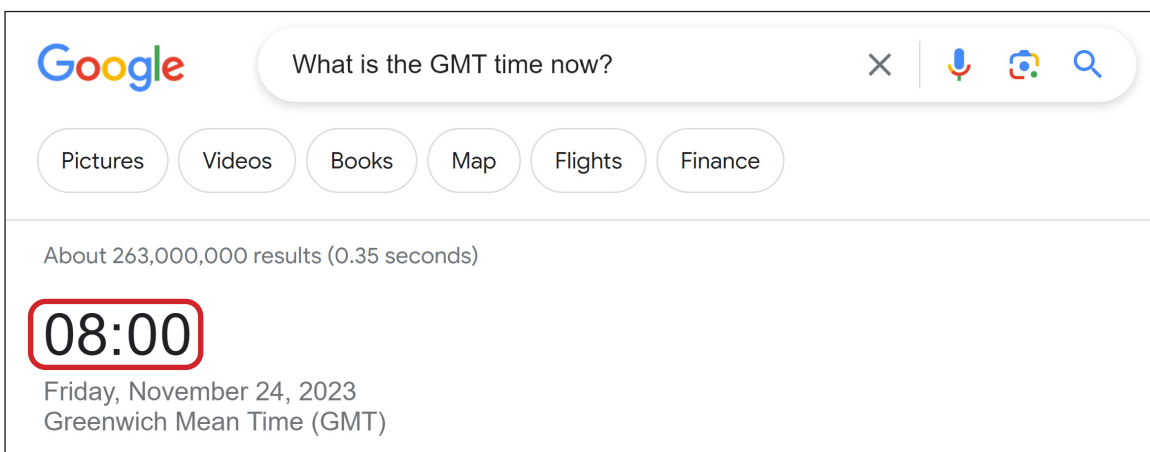

- 1 Start by opening your browser and searching for the current local time in your city.



- 2 In the second step, a search for the GMT time using your browser again.



- 3 Calculate the time difference between your city and the GMT time zone.

08:00 - 03:00 = 5 hours (as seen above)

- 4 Proceed to identify the specific exam period in your local time.

00:00 (28 January 2024): Exam start time in GMT

- 5 hours your local time difference

19:00 (27 January 2024): **EXAM START TIME** in your local time

+ 24 hours exam period

19:00 (28 January 2024): **EXAM END TIME** in your local time
