In addition, we will provide shuttle services at scheduled times between the hotels and EUR Magliana metro station.

Each group is responsible for planning its own itinerary and transportation arrangements using Google Maps and local transit maps according to its travel route.

■ Metro stations and tourist areas can be very crowded throughout the trip. Please stay with your group at all times.

■ Shuttle service schedules between the metro stations and hotels are specified in the daily program. Outside these hours, public buses can also be used for transportation.

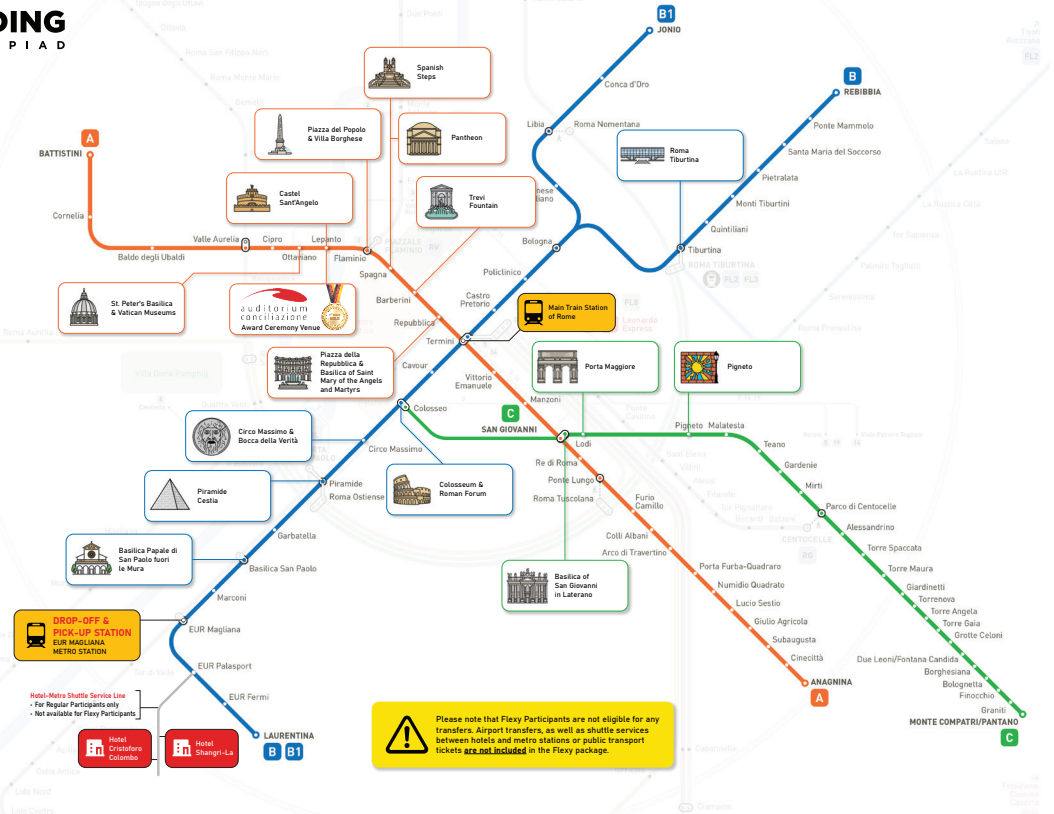
■ Transfers to the University and Cinecittà Park will be provided by private buses exclusively for Regular Participants. There is no need to use public transportation.
